<u>Coordinating the Action with INEA and producing documents and</u> reports

The coordination with INEA (CINEA in 2021) was mainly done by email. Coordination by phone or on teleconferences was also used but to a smaller extent. The INEA coordinator was present at the kick-off meeting in Zagreb and the F2F meeting was held in Zagreb between the coordinator and project manager before the first Action Status Report.

Drafting reports at the Activity level

Many reports and documents at the Activity level were created, including the following:

Creating promotional materials

At the beginning of the project, the visual identity of the Project (which consists of the logo and basic visual standards) was procured from an external firm selected through the public procurement process. All consequent material was made following the visual identity.

Following promotional material was procured and distributed among partners:

- 100 posters
- 7000 brochures (leaflets) about the project in English
- 500 brochures (leaflets) in each of the following languages: Croatian, Bosnian, Hungarian, Romanian, Slovak, Slovenian, Serbian
- 7000 ballpoint pens with applied project logo
- 700 key rings with the applied project logo
- 350 mobile phone holders with applied project logo

The promotional material was distributed to end-users during 2020 and 2021. However, this distribution was limited by the pandemic.

The procured video material consists of three parts:

- Promo video the ad for the eGAFOR product
- Video tutorial for end-users (pilots)
- "<u>Making of video</u>" for internal use to raise awareness of the management

The video material was uploaded to YouTube. The promo and the tutorial are shared via social networks, while the "making of" is distributed only among partners and to CINEA. The tutorial video is integrated into the eGAFOR Viewer (a part of the eGAFOR prototype for displaying the forecast to users) as well.

All the promotional material and videos were made following the INEA's Publicity Guidelines and contain information about the EU funding.

Presenting the Project at specialised events

The Project was promoted continuously throughout the Project duration and was presented at conferences, seminars, user meetings and similar events. In 2020 eGAFOR promotion on airshows was planned, but the COVID-19 pandemic made the promotion in person impossible since in 2020 all the airshows were cancelled. Creating and maintaining the web portal

The web portal was created before than planned, in 2018, because according to the grant agreement the reports about reached milestones had to be published on a web page.

The domain www.egafor.eu was procured in 2018 for a period of nine years. Until 2021 the website contained information about the Project (in English and all languages of the partners) and "News" and "Forum" sections. The reports were published in the "News" section.

The project web portal was made following the INEA's Publicity Guidelines and contains information about the EU funding.

Raising awareness of partners

Awareness of the management of partners had been raised throughout the Project, especially in 2019 and 2020. That was necessary because





the partners had to agree on the cooperation after the project's end and to find a way to operationally produce the eGAFOR forecast. Thanks to this effort, the partners started to operationally issue the eGAFOR forecast on 20/05/2021 as a Module in the Aviation Support Program of EUMETNET (a network of 31 European National Meteorological Services).

Effects of the pandemic and the extension of the Project's duration

The COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 significantly influenced activities in the WP1 and the Project in general. It prevented F2F meetings and made the promotion of the project more difficult. Because of the inability to organize the Joint Level Workshop (in WP4) in person, partners requested an amendment of the Grant Agreement to extend the duration of the Project until 30/06/2021. The amendment was approved and signed on 14/01/2021. Consequently, all three remaining work packages (WP1, WP3 and WP4) prolonged.

Conclusion

Due to the pandemic and the consequent project prolongation, the duration of the WP1 was extended to 30/06/2021 as well, and the deadlines for delivering the milestones were rescheduled accordingly. All the partners actively participated in all activities and tasks scheduled in the WP1 of the Project. Thanks to that, all the goals in WP1 are achieved.
